- ▶ Two letters of recommendation (teacher/school official or employer/community member/religious leader). Each letter should attest to the student's abilities and good character.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

- ▶ Return your completed application to Mrs. Toledano in Counseling.
- ► The Norco High School Scholarship Committee will select which applications are to be reviewed by the Norco Kiwanis Scholarship Team.
- ▶ Interviews, if permitted, will be scheduled in either March or April to meet with the candidates and select a recipient. Otherwise, the Norco Kiwanis Scholarship Team will make decisions based solely on the students' applications.
