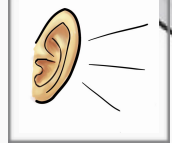


Course description:

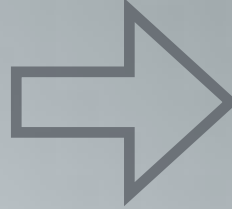
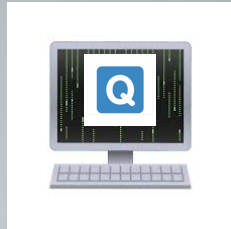


If you are not in your seat when the bell rings, I will deduct 3 points from your participation.

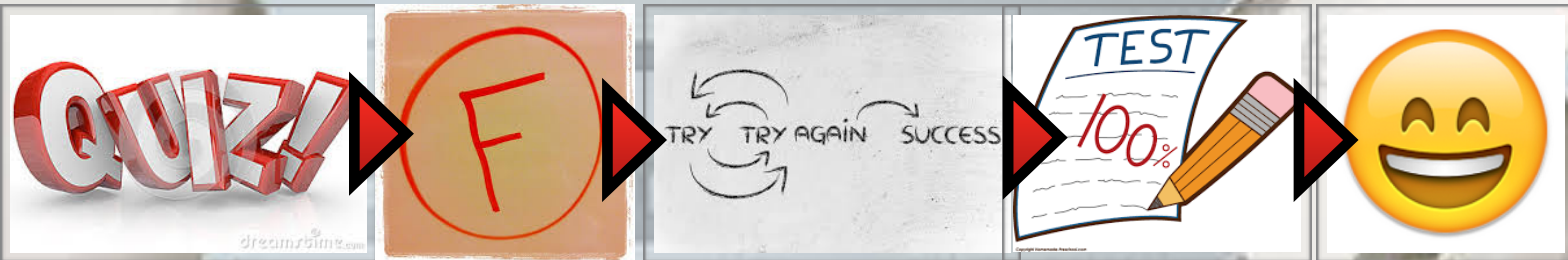


Homework is given credit on an 'ALL or NONE' completion basis. Thus, homework must be 100% completed in order to earn credit. To give a clear example, doing 95% of any assignment earns the student ZERO (0%) credit, as would doing 99% of it.

Tests and Quizzes: Many of the tests and quizzes are unannounced, so that the teacher can assess what the student has long-term memorized/learned. Students must sign up ONE DAY in advance in order to make up a quiz ON THEIR OWN TIME. Not signing up results in NOT being allowed to make-up the quiz. If you sign up, you MUST show up, or earn a grade of zero for the quiz/test you signed up for.



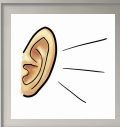
YOU CAN RE-TAKE AND MAKE UP ANY QUIZ/TEST (EXCEPT THE FINAL)!
