CLASSROOM BOOK KITS


- Class sets of novels available with a Teacher Library Card.

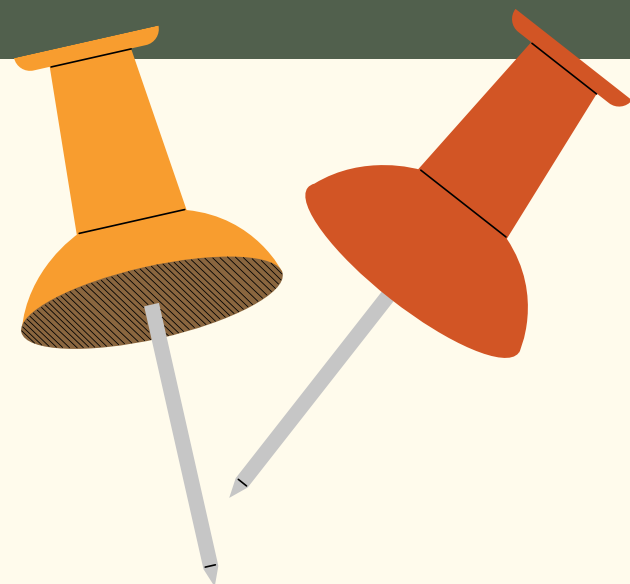

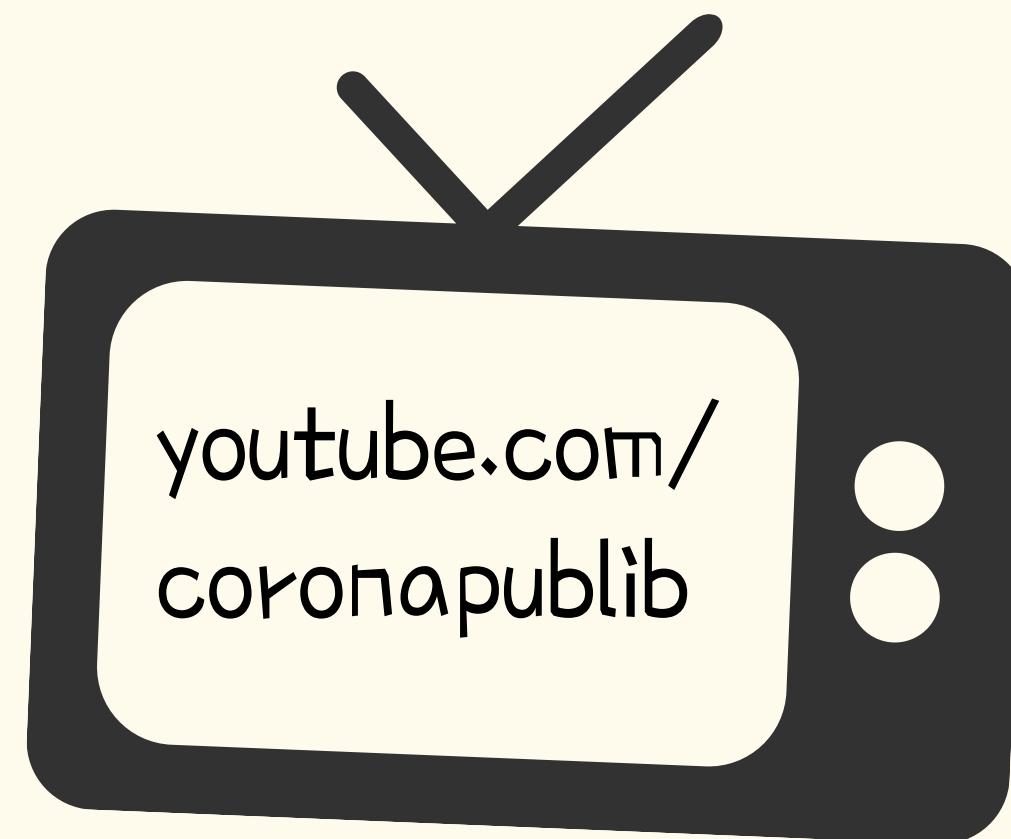

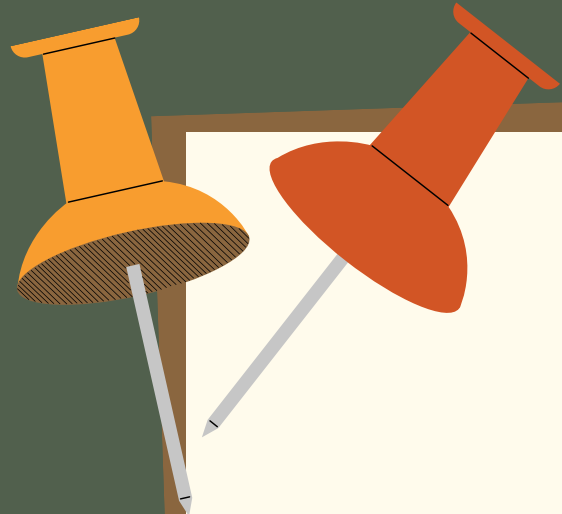
