

- Part-time & some full-time staff working Fri & Sat



  - o Ages 5+ may use in-house





- Teacher, paraeducator, or library staff
- Proof of institutional identification or a pay stub
- Teacher Cards are for materials for curriculum support or classroom use
- Borrow up to 25 items at a time
- Borrow most items up to nine weeks
- Place up to 10 items on hold
- Have exclusive access to Classroom Book Kits
- Receive a 20% discount at the Friends of the Library Bookstore

#### CLASSROOM BOOK KITS

- Class sets of novels available with a Teacher Library Card.
- Kits are checked out for 9 weeks.
- Kits come in sets of 15 or 30 and are designed for classroom instruction use or for small group book clubs (each kit includes group discussion questions).
- Classroom Book Kits are checked out at the Adult Information Desk.
